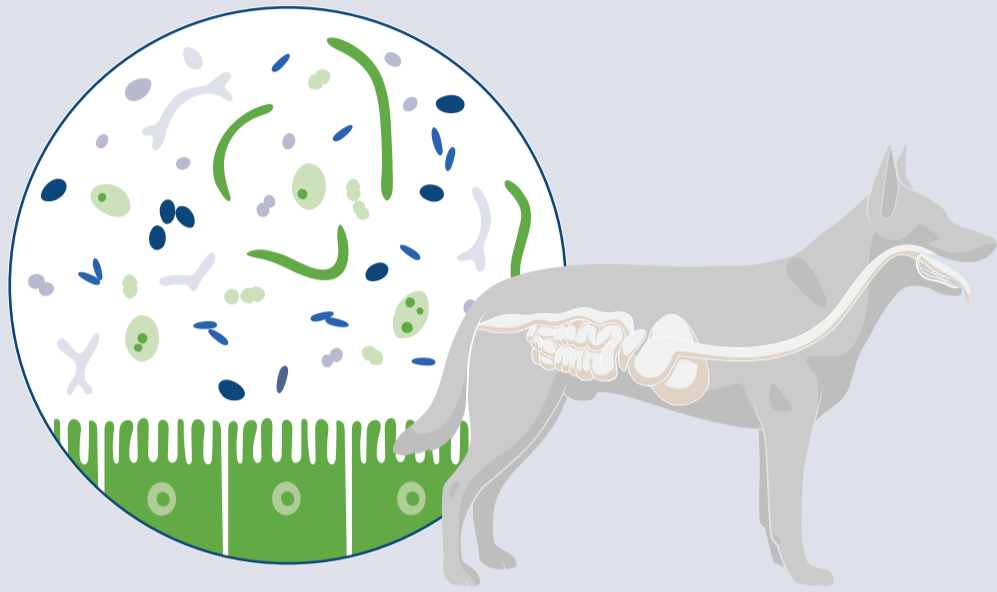


Understanding your pet's digestive health

Meet the gut microbiome

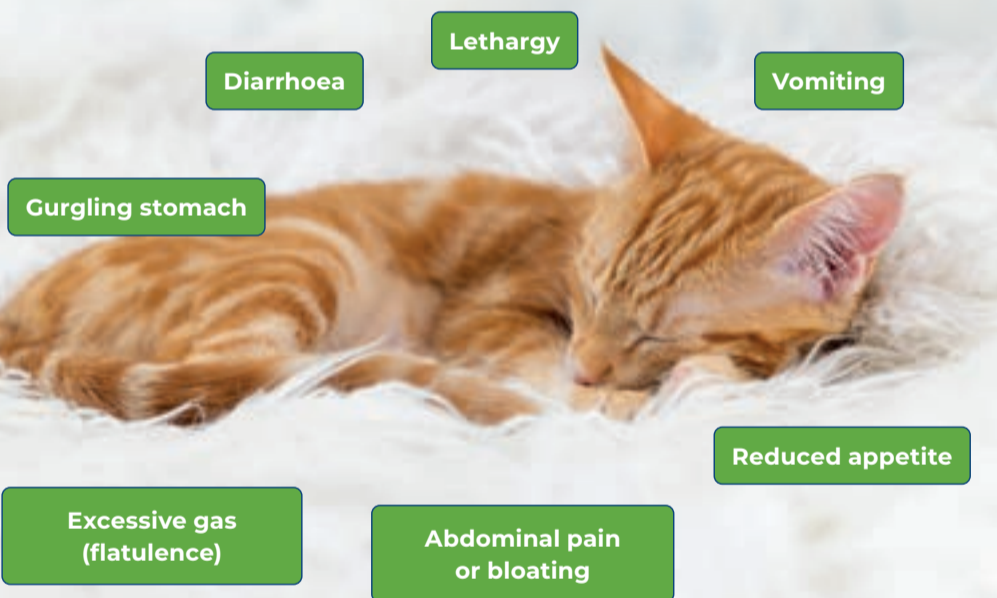
Your pet's digestive system is home to the **gut microbiome** – a community of trillions of micro-organisms, including 'good bacteria,' that are essential for both gastrointestinal health and general wellbeing.

If the balance of the microbiome is upset, this can lead to a condition called **dysbiosis**, which favours the growth of 'bad' bacteria. Restoring a balanced microbiome is an important part of managing digestive problems.

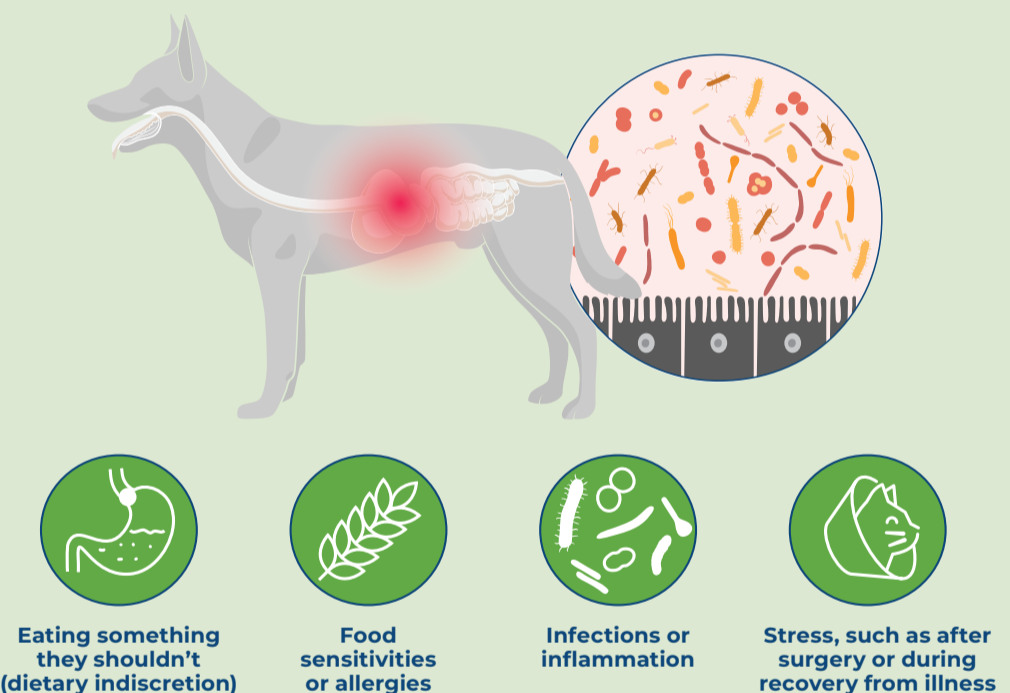
The microbiome consists of trillions of micro-organisms including bacteria, viruses and fungi.

Spotting signs of digestive upset

It is important to know what is normal for your pet so you can spot any issues early. Here's what to look out for:

When might we recommend Duotox?
